
# "A juicy contradiction"


"Street style"


The medium used was marker for the letters and oil pastel for the brick background. This isn't my favorite because it was hard for me to make the letters look in unison but I did still enjoy doing it

This was done in pencil. This was interesting to do because there was a time limit to draw it and it was kind of difficult but I really enjoyed it because I learned a lot








## "City scape"


This project was done in watercolor and it was difficult because it had to be exact and perfectly measured but it was still fun because of the end result.




#### "Dandelion"

This was done in marker. This project was really hard because it took so much time to complete and it was really tedious but it was good because it taught me to complete something even if it's really tedious and not fun.








#### "Tour Eiffel"

### "Tick Tock"


















"Myself"
